## 1. New Membership Cards

In order to prepare the new membership cards, all Members are asked to complete the attached 'Data Update' forms and provide passport size photographs, including spouse and children where necessary. Please return the completed form and photos by post to the address at the end of this mailing.

**Deadline for receipt of forms and photos: 29 February 2012**

## 2. Boat Storage and Labeling

Enclosed you will find a boat sticker for each boat you have stored at the VRC. Please affix the sticker(s) to your boat(s) by 29 February 2012 in such a position that it is clearly visible to VRC staff when your boat is on the rack or trailer.

Ensure that you affix the sticker to a clean, dry and smooth surface and leave to dry for 24 hours before taking your boat on the water.

Any boats not displaying a sticker by 29 February will have a removal notice placed upon them with a deadline for removal from the premises. The VRC will dispose of any boats not removed by the deadline.

Following the boat audit and some minor reorganization all racks will be numbered and a list of boats stored will be available in the clubhouses.

Boat storage application forms will shortly be available for Members applying for new storage space.

Waiting lists have been established for both indoor and outdoor storage spaces in Deep Water Bay so that future applications may be handled efficiently.

In case of damage or change of boat in future you may apply to the Club Manager for a new sticker. A charge of \$50 per sticker will be levied.

Please complete and return by fax, email or post (details at the bottom of this mailing) the enclosed direct debit form if your current direct debit limit does not cover your current boat storage charge.
